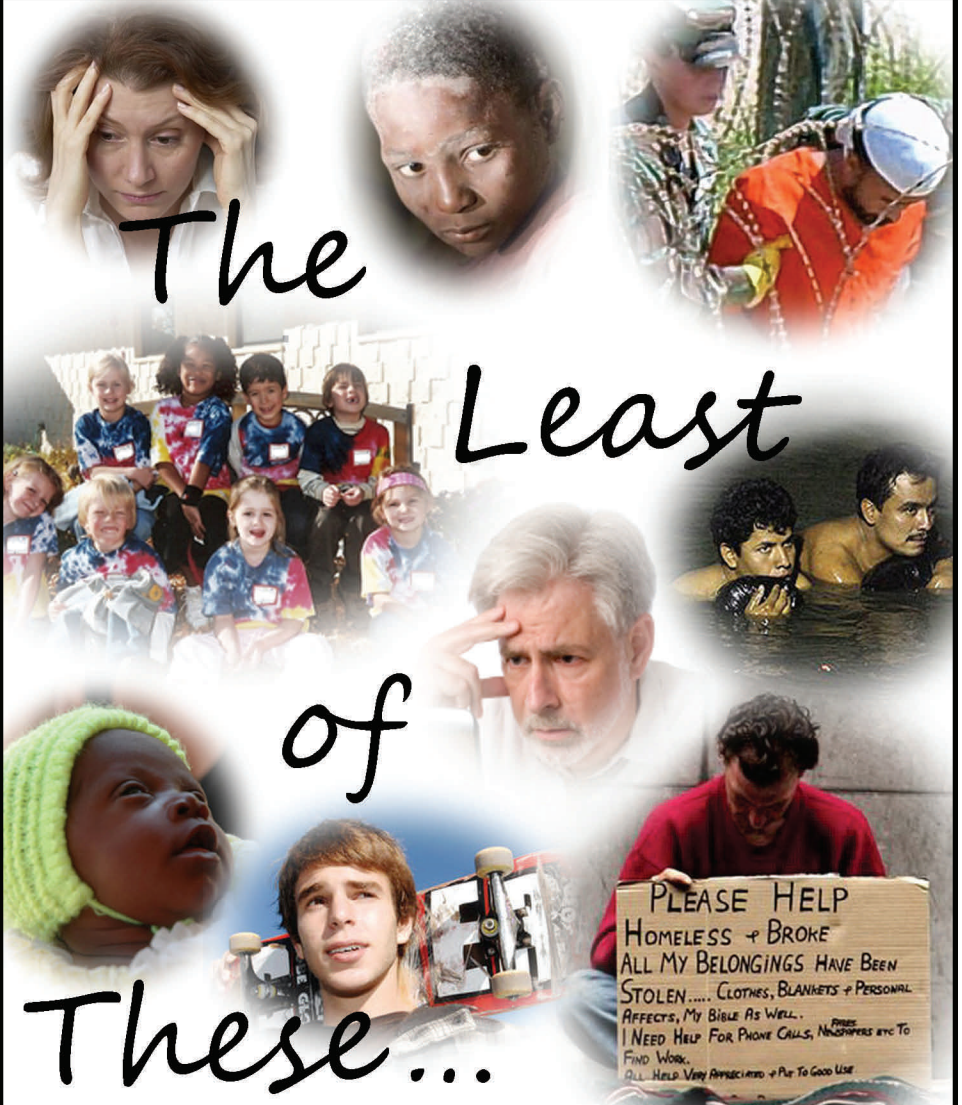

The Sheep and the Goats

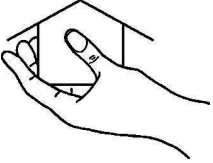

When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?’ “The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’

“Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.’ “They also will answer, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?’ “He will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.’ “Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.”

Johnny Whitehair's Biography:

I was born and raised in West Virginia. I head the Storehouse of God, which is located in Bertha Hills, West Virginia, an old coal mining area. The Storehouse of God ministry began about 11 years ago and Pleasant Hills Church has been with us since the very beginning. It is dedicated to the glory of God as we minister to an area where the poverty rate is around 65%. God has been good to us. My wife is Maria. I look forward to speaking to the faithful people of Pleasant Hills and we thank you for supporting so faithfully this outreach mission.



The Storehouse of God is a Christian outreach organization based on Bertha Hill, near Osage, West Virginia that helps the lost and hurting people in local communities by meeting their physical and spiritual needs:

- **Service projects:** During the summer and fall months, the Storehouse of God partners with church groups to perform work on homes in the community.
- **Christmas Distribution:** As many as 250 people are helped each Christmas season. Each family receives free gifts and prayer.
- **Light Night:** Each fall, we host the community for a harvest festival, giving God thanks for His provision.
- **Kids' club:** The kids' club meets weekly to encourage children to learn positive life skills and asset development.
- **Bicycle "earn-away" program:** Children learn from older teen and adult mentors as they repair bicycles. After they complete ten hours of service in the program, they receive their own bicycle.
- **Washer/dryer program:** When a struggling family's washer or dryer breaks down, we offer them a replacement from our inventory.
- **Automobile program:** When a struggling family has no transportation, we offer them a vehicle from our inventory.

As Jesus begins to call his first disciples, he commissions them with the words, "Follow me, and I will make you fish for people." (NRSV) There is a difference between believing and following and we will be talking about that next Sunday.

The Annual Meeting of Pleasant Hills Community Presbyterian Church will take place Sunday, January 30, 2011, following the joint worship service at 10:00 AM in the Great Room. The meeting will include the report of the permanent Nominating Committee (Linda Stout, chair and Steve Ament, co-chair) and their slate of nominees for Elder and Deacon, a review of the 2011 balanced budget as approved by session and dismissal of the Associate Pastor Nominating Committee.
