Next Sunday, March 6

We will be celebrating Transfiguration Sunday on March 6th. Three of the four gospels record the story of Jesus taking Peter, James and John to a high mountain and there the three catch a glimpse of his true glory and splendor. This Sunday in the church year comes just before Ash Wednesday, the start of Lent. We have sometimes thought of the transfiguration as God pulling back a curtain to prove to the disciples that he is from God. But there is another way to look at it, that Jesus was asking for God’s direction, help and guidance. Luke speaks of Jesus’ “departure,” meaning his death. On the mountain, Jesus receives confirmation that it is God’s will to proceed to Jerusalem where he will offer his life for the world’s sin. The scripture readings will be Exodus 24:9-18 and Matthew 17:1-9.

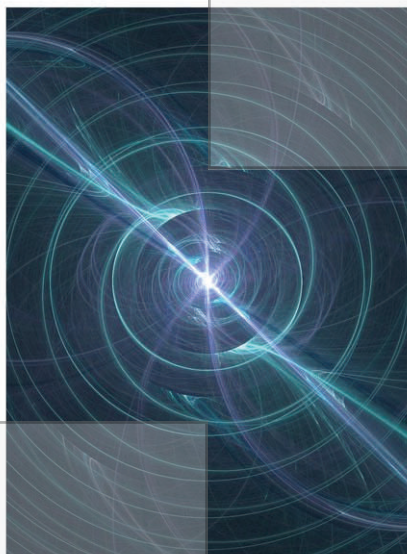


2011 Lenten Concert Series
