Small Group Discussion Questions

Summer 2020

For the remainder of the summer, use the following method to guide your small group discussions. This is the *Chapter Summary Bible Study Method*.

Watch the livestream of [Church Online](#) from Sunday. Then, read the Bible passage again with your small group, including the surrounding verses if the passage is short. Finally, use the steps below to study and discuss the passage together.

1. **Caption:** Give the chapter a short but descriptive heading. Headings that are short and/or convey a vivid image of the chapter are especially beneficial.
2. **Contents:** Make a list or outline of the major points of the chapter.
3. **Chief People:** Make a list of the major individuals in the chapter.
4. **Central Verse:** Select a verse that is most significant in the chapter and underline it.
5. **Crucial Words:** Make a list of the key words of the chapter.
6. **Challenges:** List any difficulties you have with the chapter. What don't you understand? Are there areas of your life that need to be changed, but cannot be changed very easily?
7. **Christ Revealed:** Does this passage point specifically to Jesus? If so, how?
8. **Central Lessons:** List the major life-lessons (new or old) taught in the chapter.
9. **Conclusion:** Apply what you have learned. Here are two important questions to ask: How do these lessons apply to me personally? What am I going to do about them?
